Resistance to Care

It is important to know who the person is that you are trying to help. A person with dementia may not be able to tell you what is bothering them. Understanding an individual's personal history may provide clues as to why they are resistant. Providing care to someone with dementia is not about being right. Logical reasoning is not always possible, and neither is trying to explain or convince someone why they need help. A seasoned caregiver will choose their battles. Safety and compassion are most important when helping a person with a cognitive impairment.

Food, Glorious Food!

At Keepsake Village at Greenpoint, our residents are provided with all meals, snacks and hydration in a supervised environment. This is a State Regulation and it is for their safety. We ask that families do not leave food or beverages in their loved one's apartments. Should a family wish to bring in a special treat or occasional meal for their loved one, the food must be labeled, and dated, and the case manager or a nurse must be notified. We thank you for your cooperation.
